**S**ituated on a knoll of calcareous sandstone, Zellenberg, a small winegrowing town to the east of Riquewihr, dominates a fine vineyard. Facing south-south-east, the 14,60 ha Fröhn lines the steep hillside at 270 to 300 metres of altitude.

**I**t is a marl-clay soil, made of dark grey schistous marl, showing some small white calcareous layers and also some carbonated and iron rich nodules.

**T**he Fröhn favours the cultivation of Gewurztraminer, Pinot Gris and Muscat.

**I**n his work of reference, Médard Barth cites the Fröhn as one of the finest vineyards of the period.

**F**röhn wines are noted for their fruitiness and full flavour. Their richness confers excellent ageing potential.

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
